

# STACEY DOOLEY 9 TO 5 ACTIVITY (SEND)

## CAREERS LEADER / STAFF GUIDANCE NOTES

### OVERVIEW

These guidance notes will provide Careers Leaders and other staff with an overview of the activity which can be undertaken by their students with or without additional support.

This resource has been specifically designed to be used as a discussion activity with SEND students.

If a pupil can, please ensure they complete this activity independently.

This activity will allow students to improve their knowledge and understanding of the world of work. After watching a specific careers related documentary, students will work with a teacher to share their thoughts, feedback and any knowledge gained in a group discussion.

This activity will be expanded upon by asking students to conduct some further research into the job roles featured within the documentary and then answer a series of further questions relating to the job roles / industry sectors which have been featured. This activity can be delivered over several lessons.

This activity should enable students with SEND with the ability to begin to understand that there should be no barriers standing in their way should they wish to undertake a specific career pathway.
