

# YEAR 7 LMI LESSON 1

## UK EMPLOYMENT LESSON PLAN



### Bell task: (5 minutes)

Sketch image from the board (houses of parliament) This is a running theme through the 'UK' scheme of work to improve pupils sketching technique but also understanding of features across the UK.

### Starter: (10 minutes)

Choose an item from the box in pairs or small groups. Pupils need to think of as many different employment opportunities related to that item. (LMI in a box support sheet for teachers)

### Teacher led discussion: (5 minutes)

Introducing the primary, secondary, tertiary and quaternary employment sectors, and the idea that jobs are grouped together, based upon skills and types of employment.

### Pie chart analysis: (15 minutes)

It is an important part of Geography curriculum that pupils understand employment patterns are changing. **(10 mins)** Pupils create their own pie chart for future years – **(5 mins)** how does that trend fit with previous discussions? Why are we experiencing these changes?
