

YEAR 7 LMI LESSON 3

CONTEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT LESSON PLAN



Bell task: (5 minutes)

Sketch image from the board (Darlington indoor market) this is a running theme through the 'UK' scheme of work to improve pupils sketching technique but also understanding of features across the UK.

Starter: (5 minutes)

Key word match up, ensuring pupils are comfortable with the terminology e.g. industry, employment, manufacturing etc.

Map analysis: (2 x 4 mins)

Students evaluate the importance of Tees Valley based upon the maps given. Firstly, complete individual annotations of what they can see from the map. This should then lead into a class discussion ensuring students are aware of the special position Tees Valley is in with regards to the range of transport infrastructure, but also the available workforce. We want students to realise they are in this catchment –the immediate relevance of what we are discussing.

Question grid: (20 mins)

Students have a learning mat containing information on the districts within Tees Valley – population, businesses, etc. (spend a few minutes ensuring pupils are comfortable with the content and layout). Using that information students have to gain as many 'points' as possible in the time available. Each question on the board is colour-coded with questions being worth 1, 2, 3 or 4 points. (Differentiation as students can set their own level of challenge).

Peer assessment: (7 minutes)

Students will swap and mark peer's work (according to school policy i.e. at Hurworth this would be in green and improvements in purple). Encouraging students to be critical of their peers work means they have the opportunity to interpret data they may not have utilised in their own question selection.

Plenary: Summary tweet: (5 minutes)

Demonstrate understanding of Tees Valley through the summary limited to 140 characters – encourage creative hashtags!

Additional exit token: (5 minutes)

What questions do you still have outstanding about Tees Valley?
