<b>Solo exhibition</b>		<b>This type of exhibition focuses on a selection of works that are relevant to a particular topic or theme.</b>
<b>Collective exhibition</b>		<b>This exhibition illustrates all the phases of an artist's artistic work respecting the chronological order.</b>
<b>Temporary exhibition</b>		<b>It includes set-ups in various locations and times. It can ensure a greater audience and reduce fixed costs.</b>
<b>Itinerant exhibition</b>		<b>This type of exhibition focuses on the work of a single artist, who can choose to propose more recent work or most famous pieces.</b>
<b>Online exhibition</b>		<b>It has a short duration, from a few weeks to months.</b>
<b>Anthological exhibition</b>		<b>This type of exhibition is dedicated to multiple artists sharing a theme or an artistic movement.</b>
<b>Retrospective exhibition</b>		<b>The displays are placed in the online dimension. It can take place through tours and virtual experiences. The online exhibition can reach new audiences and ensure new experiences.</b>
