Solo exhibition		This type of exhibition focuses on a selection of works that are relevant to a particular topic or theme.
Collective exhibition		This exhibition illustrates all the phases of an artist's artistic work respecting the chronological order.
Temporary exhibition		It includes set-ups in various locations and times. It can ensure a greater audience and reduce fixed costs.
Itinerant exhibition		This type of exhibition focuses on the work of a single artist, who can choose to propose more recent work or most famous pieces.
Online exhibition		It has a short duration, from a few weeks to months.
Anthological exhibition		This type of exhibition is dedicated to multiple artists sharing a theme or an artistic movement.
Retrospective exhibition		The displays are placed in the online dimension. It can take place through tours and virtual experiences. The online exhibition can reach new audiences and ensure new experiences.
