# Preparing the session

- Circulate the <u>Talking Futures toolkit</u> as a pre-read in advance of the meeting.
- The slides in the template include delivery notes.
- Adapt the template to suit the knowledge of the people attending the meeting. Most members of the SLT and governors will have a good understanding of the careers and education options landscape. However, they may not be familiar with new qualifications such as T-levels, and, especially if they are new in post, they may favour one route over another.
- Complete the slides at the end of the session with information about your planned activities.

## After the session

- Send round a list of agreed actions with timescales and a recap of responsibilities as soon as possible after the meeting to maintain buy-in.
- You may want to set up regular meetings with the staff responsible for supporting you at SLT and governor level, for promoting the programme and for communicating to parents.
